## Visitor code of conduct

### Collection care is everyone's responsibility.

This building is designed to protect and showcase Canada's national science and innovation collection. For the safety of Ingenium's visitors and the national collection, please refrain from:










-  Touching artifacts
-  Moving quickly through the collection
-  Bringing any food or drink into collection rooms
-  Disruptive or abusive behaviour towards staff and other visitors

Throughout your visit, we encourage you to:

-  Stay with your tour group at all times
-  Take photos of the collection. Please be respectful of visitors and staff while using your camera
-  Ask questions

### Other considerations:

-  Children (under 12) must be accompanied by an adult
-  Wear proper attire. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times
-  Pets are not permitted in the Ingenium Centre, however, service animals are permitted
-  The Ingenium Centre is smoke-free (including e-cigarettes). There are designated smoking areas outside
-  The following items are not permitted inside the Ingenium Centre at any time:
  -  Bicycles, scooters, skateboards, roller skates
  -  Drugs and alcohol
  -  Weapons of any type, or other items deemed dangerous to people or the collection
  -  Any item prohibited under the Criminal Code of Canada
