Without counting, estimate how many pellets of solid fuel are in this picture. Circle the answer.



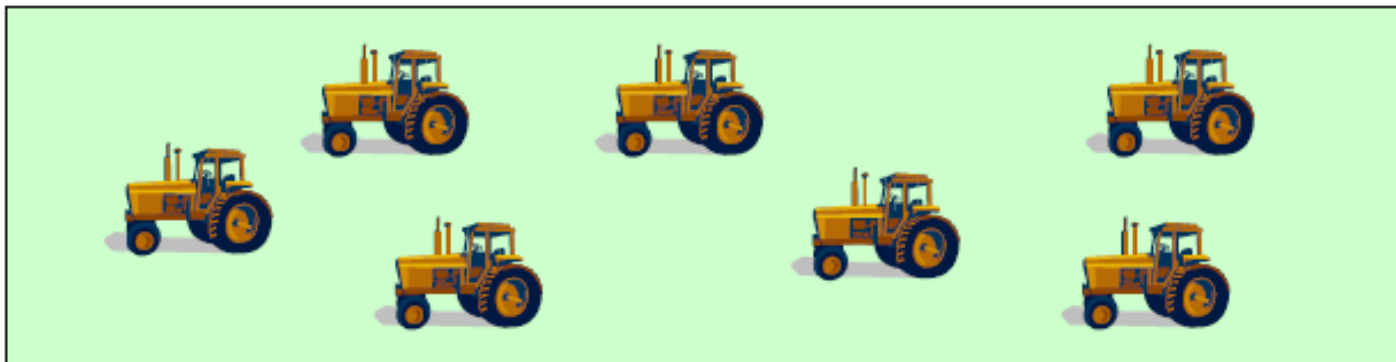

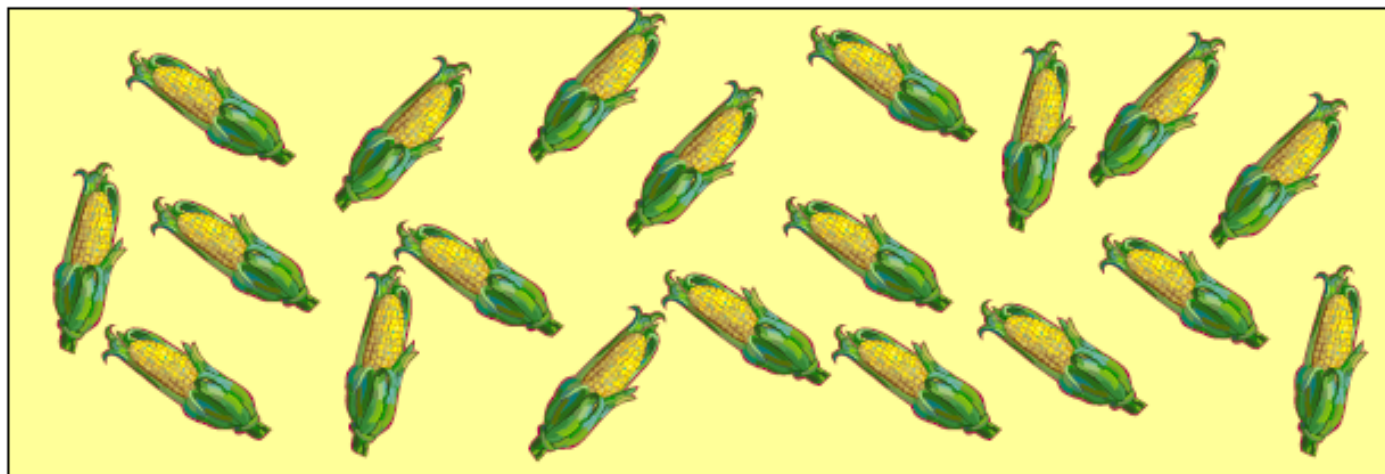
These tractors run on biodiesel. Biodiesel is a liquid fuel made from canola and soy plants.
